A research position is available in the group of Reto Gassmann at the Institute for Molecular and Cell Biology in Porto. The fellowship is funded for 6 months by an ERC Starting Grant.

Our group is interested in how co-factors regulate the motor cytoplasmic dynein, which is responsible for microtubule minus-end-directed transport in animal cells and has multiple essential roles in cell division. The successful candidate will characterize the role of dynein co-factors during embryogenesis using *C. elegans* as an animal model.

Candidates will be considered who meet the following requirements:

- Master's degree in cell biology
- Experience with the animal model *C. elegans* and fluorescence microscopy
