A research position is available in the group of Reto Gassmann at the Institute for Molecular and Cell Biology in Porto. The fellowship is funded by an ERC Starting Grant, initially for 12 months and is eventually renewable until February 2019.

Our group is interested in how co-factors regulate the motor cytoplasmic dynein, which is responsible for microtubule minus-end-directed transport in animal cells and has multiple essential roles in cell division. The successful candidate will characterize the role of dynein co-factors during embryogenesis using *C. elegans* as an animal model.

Candidate requirements:

- Master's degree in cell biology or a related area
- Experience with the animal model *C. elegans* and fluorescence microscopy
- Creativity, perseverance, and passion for basic science
- Strong oral and written communication skills in English
