Title: Master Fellowships for HOST

IBMC/i3S is opening **1 (one) Research Fellowship Position** to join its Research Program: Structured Programme on Bioengineering Therapies for Infectious Diseases and Tissue Regeneration

We are looking for 1 Fellow holding a Master Degree in Biology, Biochemistry or related fields with lab experience, a minimum weighted average (degree/master degree) of 15 out of 20 and that is interested in pursuing a PhD program. Preference is given to candidates with experience in (i) manipulation of biosafety laboratory level 3 pathogens, such as *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, (ii) human cells culture and animal handling, (iii) molecular biology.

Work Plan:

The workplan involves the growth and preparation of Mycobacterium tuberculosis clinical isolated to be used to infect human and mouse immune cells. The cellular response to infection will be followed in terms of cytokine production, bacterial control and alteration of basic processes. The work also involves the mouse model of infection.

The successful candidate will integrate the following group: Immune Regulation.

The work will be developed at Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Saúde - i3S, Porto, Portugal.

The Master Fellowships will be for 10 months, not renewable, and is expected to start in <u>April 1st 2017</u>.
