Title: Characterization of mouse models for human peroxisomal diseases.

IBMC/i3S is opening **1 (one) Postdoctoral Fellowship** to join the Research program of Neurolipid Biology within The Neurobiology and Neurologic Disorders programme.

We are looking for a Fellow holding a PhD in Biology, Biochemistry or related fields with less than three years of Post-Doctoral experience. The applicant must have expertise in molecular biology, cell biology (primary cultures of cells, microscopy and mouse experimentation (certified FELASA B). Previous knowledge and experience in peroxisomal functions and mouse neuropathology caused by defective peroxisomal functioning will be evaluated positively. English language, both spoken and written, and good inter-personal relationships in the context of a multidisciplinary research team are essential attributes.

Group and PI: Neurolipid Biology Group, Pedro Brites.

Work Plan: The project will explore the characterization of available mutant mice in terms of pathohistological analyses, understanding of the cellular defects contributing to the pathology and design of candidate therapeutic approaches.

The Postdoctoral Fellowship will be for 6 months, and it is expected to start in December 1st 2017.
