



Postdoctoral Fellowship

A fellowship for a **postdoctoral researcher** is available in the group of Reto Gassmann at the Institute for Molecular and Cell Biology in Porto. The fellowship (1'495 Euros/month) is funded by an ERC Starting Grant and is renewable until February 2019.

Our group is interested in the cellular functions and the regulation of cytoplasmic dynein, a molecular motor that is responsible for microtubule minus-end-directed transport in animal cells and has multiple essential roles in cell division. The postdoctoral researcher will characterize the role and mechanism of action of dynein co-factors in the animal model *C. elegans*. He/she will have access to the group's own state-of-the-art light microscopes and protein purification equipment and will be able to regularly attend international scientific conferences.

We are looking for someone with a passion for basic science who is highly motivated, hardworking, and capable of driving a project forward independently.

Additional requirements:

- PhD in biochemistry, molecular biology, or a related area with a strong track record of publications in international peer-reviewed journals
- Excellent oral and written skills in English
- Proven expertise in fluorescence microscopy, protein expression and purification methods, molecular cloning, or genetics (any model organism) will be valued
